

# Catechism at HIGHLANDS School: A Spiritual Journey for Children

As part of our commitment to passing on Christian values, we offer families a **structured and adapted catechism program** starting from **CE2 (3rd grade)**, in collaboration with **St. Ambroise Ma Vigne Parish in Angré**. This program guides children in discovering the **Catholic faith**, prepares them for the **sacraments**, and helps them deepen their understanding of **Christ's teachings**.

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## Catechism Course Structure

- **Years 1 & 2:** Introduction to the Faith
  - **Year 3:** Preparation for First Communion
  - **Year 4:** Deepening the Christian Life
  - **Year 5:** Preparation for Confirmation
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## An Engaging and Living Catechism

- Celebrations & Retreats:** Participation in school Masses, confessions, the Way of the Cross, and moments of reflection.
- Acts of Solidarity:** Raising awareness of charitable initiatives and encouraging students to take part in projects that help those in need.
- Class Frequency:** Once a week on Wednesday afternoons.

Our catechism classes allow children to **grow in faith** while integrating **Gospel values** into their daily lives.
