Catechism Course Structure

- Years 1 & 2: Introduction to the Faith

- Year 4: Deepening the Christian Life
- Year 5: Preparation for Confirmation

- -**Celebrations & Retreats:** Participation in school Masses, confessions, the Way of the Cross, and moments of reflection.
- -Acts of Solidarity: Raising awareness of charitable initiatives and encouraging students to take part in projects that help those in need.
- -Class Frequency: Once a week on Wednesday afternoons.

Our catechism classes allow children to **grow in faith** while integrating **Gospel values** into their daily lives.
